## Poster criteria

All entries must meet the below criteria in order to be eligible for entry.

- Drawn using any of the following mediums – pencils, textas, paint, crayons, glitter, stickers. There is no limitation on the use and number of colours. There is no limitation on the type of media – such as print, crayon, felt pen, etc. – used on the poster design; however, wood, plastic, glass, or metal should not be part of the poster.
- Poster designs may not incorporate any copyrighted characters (i.e. comic and/or television characters), photographs, and magazine or newspaper illustrations.

- Drawings must be original, correct in safety concept, and the exclusive work of the student entering the contest in idea, design and execution. All artwork should be positive in approach, demonstrating only proper safety behaviours.
- DO NOT place name, school, etc. on the front of the poster. Please include this only on the entry form.
- Provide a clear safety message for travelling on Newcastle Transport's light rail
- Have correct spelling
- Include a hand illustrated Newcastle Transport logo
- Include the words 'Celebrate Safety'
- Contain original illustrations clearly demonstrating one of the following:
  - Safe behaviour
  - Good hygiene and Covid-safe travel

Entries which do not meet the above criteria will be deemed invalid.

## Judging

Judging will be completed by the Keolis Downer Hunter Customer Experience department at 89 Denison Street, Hamilton NSW 2303 on 2nd August 2021 at 10:00am. Three (3) prize winners will be chosen for each age category: K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-12. This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winner(s). Posters will be judged on the following criteria:

- Safety Impact** – relationship of the poster design to the safety practices
- Originality** – originality of the poster and how the idea is expressed in the poster design
- Artistic Quality** – Artwork and its execution
- Visual Impact** – Visual impact of the poster design
- COVID safe travel** – Where relevant, how well COVID safe travel and good hygiene practices are represented
